

PRESIDENT'S LETTER

The Women's Basketball Hall of Fame is a 501 (C)3 dedicated to honoring, celebrating, and promoting the sport of women's basketball. Since our opening in 1999 we have continually strived to honor the greats of the game and empower future generations of players, coaches, and fans. The idea of a women's hall of fame was established in 1991 with the dream being fulfilled with our grand opening in June of 1999.

The WBHOF has operated with two board of directors since our opening, the Hall of Fame Management Inc. board responsible for the operations of the WBHOF (local) and the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Inc. board responsible for determining our Induction class (national). Both boards came together in 2018 with the desire to create one entity and one non-profit.

In January of 2021 we will have completed our merger of the two boards. The Women's Basketball Hall of Fame will have a Board of Trustees and a Board of Governors. This move eliminates duplicity in efforts and expenses.

"We are so excited about this merger and know that we will be stronger together. We look forward to continued collaboration between both groups as we move the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame forward as a strong defined entity" stated Dana Hart, President of the WBHOF.
