REPORT OF THE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME, INC. SCREENING COMMITTEE MEETING

The Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Screening Committee submits the following report from its June 9, 2018 meeting. The meeting convened at 9:05 a.m. and adjourned at 10:40 a.m.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS.

- 1. Approval of December 6, 2017 Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Screening Committee Teleconference Report. The committee reviewed the December 6, 2017 Screening Committee teleconference report.
- 2. Introduction and Review of Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Value Statement. The committee reviewed the proposed Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. value statement. The Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. attorney recommended the development and adoption of a value statement as a "best business" practice.
- **3.** Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Class of 2019 Update. The Screening Committee discussed the presentation of the 20 candidates for the Class of 2019 to the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Board of Directors. The Screening Committee agreed that the following presentation procedure would be followed:
 - The Screening Committee chair will introduce each candidate to the Board of Directors.
 - The Board of Directors will be provided an opportunity to review the candidate's biographical information.
 - Following the biographical information review, a "comment" session will be conducted to allow Board of Director members to provide information on the candidate
 - Each candidate will be reviewed and discussed for a maximum of five minutes.
- **4. Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Class of 2019 Communication/Notification Timeline.** The Screening Committee reviewed the Class of 2019 communication/notification timeline. Additional information will be provided to the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Board of Directors in accordance with the timeline.

Note: Based on discussions of the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Board of Directors in regard to the initial announcement of the Trailblazer Award recipient, followed by the Inductee Class finalists and Inductee Class, the communication timeline will be revised.

- 5. Determination of the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame 2019 Trailblazer Award Recipient. The Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Board of Directors previously approved the 1980 USA Olympic women's basketball team as the recipient of the 2020 Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Trailblazer Award. The Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Executive Committee recommended that the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) be recognized as the 2021 Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Trailblazer Award recipient. The Screening Committee discussed organizations to be considered for the 2019 and 2022 Trailblazer Award.
- 6. Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Selection Process Revisions Recommended from the Executive Committee (Bylaw Revisions). The Screening Committee reviewed the following selection

process revisions provided by the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Executive Committee. The proposed process revisions are intended to simplify and streamline the inductee selection process.

- Individuals must be nominated no later than November 1 of each year in order to be considered for the next class and remain eligible for future consideration.
- Elimination of Screening Committee subcommittees. The Screening Committee will be responsible for reviewing the master nomination list and determining individuals recommended to be moved from the master nomination list (big bucket) to the master candidate list (small bucket).
- Initial Ballot The Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Screening Committee will select a minimum of 10 and a maximum of 20 individuals to advance in the selection process.
- Second Ballot The Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Board of Directors will select a minimum of 10 and a maximum of 12 individuals as finalists for the designated class.
- Final Ballot The Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Board of Directors will select a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 7 individuals as inductees for the designated class.

Note: If the recommendations are approved by the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Board of Directors, the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Bylaws will need to be revised according to Article 13 of the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Bylaws.

ACTION ITEMS.

2. Introduction and Review of Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Value Statement. The committee reviewed the proposed Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. value statement.

It was VOTED: "To approve the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. value statement and forward to the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Board of Directors for review and action." [Motion: Ms. Flannery – Second: Ms Krauskopf] [For: 6; Against: 0; Abstain: 0]

3. Determination of the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame 2019 Trailblazer Award Recipient. The Screening Committee confirmed that the 1980 USA Olympic Team as the recipient of the 2020 Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Trailblazer Award.

It was VOTED: "To recommend to the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Board of Directors that the AIAW be named as the 2019 Trailblazer Award recipient; that the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) be named as the 2021 Trailblazer Award recipient, and that advocates for Title IX be named as the 2022 Trailblazer Award recipient." [Motion: Ms. VanDerveer – Second: Mr. Bruno] [For: 6; Against: 0; Abstain: 0]

4. Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Selection Process Revisions Recommended from the Executive Committee (Bylaw Revisions). The Screening Committee reviewed selection process revisions, recommended by the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Executive Committee.

It was VOTED: "To recommend for approval to the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Board of Directors the proposed candidate selection process revisions." [Motion: Ms. Plarski – Second: Ms. Krauskopf] [For: 6; Against: 0; Abstain: 0]

Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Screening Committee Task Schedule for Class of 2019

November, 2018

- November 12 November 16, 2018 Board of Director members submit an initial electronic ballot to rank Top 20 candidates.
- The top 12 candidates will advance as finalists (one veteran candidate must be included).
- Finalists' bio information will be reviewed and finalized.

January, 2019

- Danielle Donehew contacts individuals (via phone) notifying them that they are finalists and the announcement date.
- Danielle Donehew sends congratulatory correspondence to the finalists.
- The Class of 2019 finalists announced on an ESPN platform and a press release issued.
- January 14 18, 2019 Board of Director members submit a final ballot to select 4 7 inductees.

February, 2019

- Danielle Donehew contacts individuals (via phone) notifying them they have been selected for induction into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Class of 2019.
- Danielle Donehew contacts finalists (via phone) notifying them they were not selected for induction.
- The Women's Basketball Hall of Fame staff, in conjunction with the WBCA staff and the NCAA women's basketball staff, will begin arrangements for inductee appearances at the 2019 NCAA Women's Final Four (Tampa, FL.).
- The Women's Basketball Hall of Fame staff will begin arrangements for the inductees' attendance at the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame 2019 Induction Weekend.
- The 2019 Trailblazer Award recipient (AIAW contributors) announced on an ESPN platform and a press release issued.
- The Class of 2019 inductees announced on an ESPN platform and a press release issued.
- Women's Basketball Hall of Fame 2019 Induction Weekend tickets available when announcements are made and press releases are issued.

April, 2019

 April 5 – 7, 2019 – Introduction of the Class of 2019 and the Trailblazer Award recipients at the NCAA Women's Final Four (Tampa, FL.).

June, 2019

• June 7 – 9, 2019 – Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Induction Weekend.

August/September/October, 2018

- Board of Directors, Screening Committee and Screening Subcommittee members submit and/or solicit nominations for individuals, who meet the minimum requirements, for consideration for induction into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Nominations must be submitted (via WBHOF.com) prior to November 1 in order to be considered for induction into the next class.

November, 2018

- Screening Committee and Screening Committee Subcommittee members determine candidates to move from the Master Nomination List to the Master Candidate List, individuals to return to the Master Nomination List, individuals on the Master Candidate List to remove from consideration (do not meet minimum requirements).
- November 19 21, 2018 Screening Committee Subcommittee chairs submit recommendations (via email):
 - Individuals to move to Master Candidate List a maximum of 5 nominees.
 - Individuals to return to Master Nomination List.
 - Individuals to remove from consideration (do not meet minimum standards).
- November 26 30, 2018 Screening Committee Electronic Vote to determine:
 - Individuals to move to Master Candidate List.
 - Individuals to return to Master Nomination List.
 - Individuals to remove from consideration (do not meet minimum standards).

December, 2018

- **December 5, 2018** (2 p.m. ET/1 p.m. CT/Noon MT/11 a.m. PT) Screening Committee Call Review vote results and initiate study of Master Candidate List.

December, 2018/January, 2019

• Screening Committee reviews Master Candidate List.

February 26 – 28, 2019

- Screening Committee submits electronic ballot to select a minimum of 10 candidates and a maximum of 20 candidates for consideration by the Board of Directors for the Class of 2020.
- Individuals not selected in the Class of 2020 selection process will be returned to Master Candidate List.

June, 2019

• June 7 – 9, 2019 – The Board of Directors will review and discuss the candidate slate during its' annual Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, Inc. Board of Directors meeting.
